The Circle Bar Ranch Music Camp is located in the relaxed and peaceful setting of Truscott, Texas.



Camp will begin with a meet and greet on Sunday afternoon. Check in is from 2-4 p.m. Following check in, a brief one-on-one will allow the instructors to properly place the student in the correct class: beginner, intermediate, or advanced.

Dinner will be served at 6 p.m.

After dinner, we will have a jam session to relax and start playing. The casual atmosphere allows the students to get to know the instructors and each other.



Each day consists of music theory, music class, and a band rehearsal. Circle Bar Ranch provides three delicious meals a day. Following dinner is free time where students will be able to join in a jam session, study, or just relax and play cards or shoot a game of pool.

The camp is under the direction of Glenn McLaughlin and Elizabeth (Terry) Van Hersh.

Glenn McLaughlin is a professional musician based in DFW. He began piano lessons at the age of 5. At 16 years old, he began playing guitar and quickly took up gigs in his sister's western swing group, the Ginny Mac Band. McLaughlin began college in Denton, TX pursuing a Jazz Studies degree from the University of North Texas, while remaining heavily involved in Western Swing, country, and cowboy music. McLaughlin has been teaching students via city Arts Council/school district programs, music camps, and private lessons across the US since 2006. Glenn worked and collaborated musical teachings with Western Swing greats such as Joe Settlemires, Tommy Allsup, Rich O'Brien, Ronnie Dale Shultz, Dave Holcomb, Coleman Smith, Bobby Flores, Jess Meador, and Jake Hooker.



Elizabeth (Terry) Van Hersh began playing the violin at four years old. Originally from Pampa, Texas, she was classically trained for ten years. After her classical instructor retired, her mother stumbled upon the Bobby Boatright Western Swing Music camp, now the Circle Bar Ranch Music camp, and she has attended or taught the camp ever since. She teaches private fiddle lessons and instructs various ages and experience levels through the camp. Although Elizabeth is not a full-time musician, she thoroughly enjoys teaching and playing in her spare time.

The camp closes Thursday afternoon with a student concert for family, friends, and the community.

There will be adult supervision the entire week for students under 18. Students will be placed in rooms with the same age group participants. Most rooms will be two or three students per room. **\*\*If a student is under 8, we request a parent stay with them.\*\***
